As stated in Float Rule 39: All boat owners must have a mandatory insurance liability requirement of \$300,000.00 per boat and proof must be submitted to the Float Committee before a boat is allowed on the floats. This is required by our club insurance policy. **No insurance, no float space!** All Insurance Policies are required to be on file at the club for all boats. Have your insurance agent fax your insurance cover page to the club at (617) 207-9826, or drop a copy off at the office.

A reminder... please remove your dinghy from the dinghy dock for the winter.
